# Ambassador Activities

Below is a list of suggested activities for IChC Ambassadors. These ideas can support your outreach efforts. Be sure to document and submit your actions through your Ambassador account. You're also welcome to explore additional initiatives beyond this list.

## **Promote IChC on Social Media**

Help spread awareness by sharing official IChC posts and information across platforms such as Facebook and Instagram. Tag the official pages to help increase visibility.

## **Add Your IChC Ambassador Role to Profiles**

Display your IChC role proudly on your social and professional platforms like LinkedIn or Facebook. You can include a link to your ambassador profile.

## **Share IChC with Friends and Classmates**

Talk to peers in your school, university, or community about IChC, explaining what the competition is and why it's exciting. Encourage them to participate.

## **Talk to Teachers and Coordinators**

Introduce IChC to teachers, club mentors, and school officials. Provide information about the educator platform and special awards for schools.

## **Present IChC in Classes or Clubs**

Give a brief presentation about the competition during a class session or club meeting to spark interest among students.

## **Distribute Posters and Flyers**

Print and hang official IChC posters at school, community centers, or libraries to attract attention. Digital copies can be found on the IChC website.

## **Start a chemistry Club or Group**

Form a group at your school to explore chemistry problems together, host problem-solving sessions, or use IChC problems to build engagement.

## **Organize chemistry Workshops or Events**

Plan events like coding workshops, project showcases, or Q&A sessions where you introduce IChC and chemistry topics in an interactive way.

### **Create a Local Social Media Group**

Establish a local WhatsApp or Facebook group for your school or city to coordinate IChC efforts and share updates.

### **Collaborate with Local Organizations**

Work with local tech hubs, clubs, or institutions to promote IChC or co-host events that highlight the importance of chemistry.

### **Share IChC through Newsletters or Blogs**

Submit a short article about IChC to your school's newsletter, student blog, or internal communication platforms.

### **Encourage Other Schools to Join**

Extend outreach to other schools or universities in your area. Offer to share materials or connect them with the IChC organizing team.



### **Arrange Local Meetups**

Organize informal meetups for interested students to discuss chemistry topics and learn more about the competition together.

### **Support the Qualification Round at Your School**

### **Represent IChC at Local Events**

If your school or city hosts academic fairs, tech fests, or STEM days, represent IChC by setting up a booth or delivering a short talk.
